



## How to apply for distributed generation above 10kW in total

**Choose** the type of Distributed Generation to be connected to our networks.



**Read and understand** the regulated term for distributed generation (Schedule 6.2 of Electricity Industry Participation Code 2010).



### Initial Application

- Complete and submit the **initial application form** (refer to WNL website).
- We will send you a confirmation email within 2 business days upon receiving your initial application form and fees.
- Within 5 business days of receiving your application, we will advise in writing whether your application is complete.



### Pending for Approval 1

- Within 30 business days of receiving your completed initial application, we will provide you the information as stated in the Electricity Industry Participation Code 2010 (Part 6 - Connection of Distributed Generation, Schedule 6.1 Part 2 Clause 12).
- Within 10 business days, if required, we would provide further information that is reasonably necessary to enable you to consider and act on the original information given by us.



### Approval of Initial Application

- Once approved, if you wish to proceed with the application, you must complete and submit a **final application form** (refer to WNL website) no later than 12 month after the information above has been given to you.

**Pending for Approval 2**

- If your final application is approved, we will send you a written notice within 45 business days for generation capacity less than 1MW, 60 business days for generation capacity between 1MW and 5MW or 80 business days for generation capacity greater than 5MW.
- You must confirm in writing whether or not you intend to proceed to negotiate a connection contract.
- If no connection contract is negotiated, the regulated terms will apply for the connection of distributed generation.



**Installation, Testing and Inspection**

- The distributed generation must comply with AS 4777, regulated terms and our connection and operation standards.
- You need to provide us with adequate notice of the testing and inspection.
- We have the right to send a qualified person to observe the testing and inspection.
- You may need to provide a written test report, including suitable evidence that the distributed generation complies with our Distributed Generation Policy (refer to WNL website).
- Observation of testing and inspection fees may be charged in accordance to the fees stated below.

**FEES (excluding GST)**

The following shows a list of fees for any of the distributed generation activities as prescribed under Part 6 of Electricity Industry Participation Code 2010:

**Distributed generation above 10kW in total**

Application fee for distributed generation with nameplate capacity of more than 10kW but less than 100kW	\$500
Application fee for distributed generation with nameplate capacity of 100kW or more in total but less than 1MW	\$1000
Application fee for distributed generation with nameplate capacity of 1MW or more	\$5000
Observation of testing and inspection fee (distributed generation with nameplate capacity of more than 10kW but less than 100kW)	\$120
Observation of testing and inspection fee (distributed generation with nameplate capacity of 100kW or more)	\$1200
